# Part 1—Preliminary

### 1 Name

- (1) This instrument is Migration (LIN 20/103: Subclass 417 (Working Holiday) Visa—Regional Australia and Specified Work) Instrument 2020.
- (2) This instrument may be cited as LIN 20/103.

#### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is registered on the Federal Register of Legislation.

#### **3** Authority

This instrument is made under the definitions of *regional Australia* and *specified work* in subitem 1225(5) of Schedule 1 to the Regulations and according to subection 33(3) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*.

### 4 Definitions

In this instrument:

*bushfire recovery work* means work undertaken, including work undertaken on a volunteer basis, to assist with bushfire recovery efforts in an area mentioned in subsection 6(2), including:

- (a) construction, farming, or any other work in association with recovery or restitution of land, property, farm animals or wildlife; and
- (b) providing support services or assistance to people living, working or volunteering in the affected areas.

Regulations means the Migration Regulations 1994.

#### **5** Schedules

The instrument that is specified in Schedule 1 to this instrument is repealed as set out in that Schedule.

### 1 The whole of the instrument

The instrument is repealed.
