Financial Framework (Supplementary Powers) Regulations 1997

1 In the appropriate position in Part 4 of Schedule 1AB (table)

Insert:

405 Reducing regulatory and auditing burdens in the dairy export supply chain, and supporting Dairy RegTech 2022

To support the following:

- (a) projects to minimise the burdens, for businesses in the dairy export supply chain, of compliance with regulatory and auditing requirements;
- (b) projects to assist dairy businesses with export readiness;
- (c) projects to improve the use of data in regulation of the dairy export supply chain;
- (d) the Dairy RegTech 2022 initiative of Dairy Food Safety Victoria.

This objective also has the effect it would have if it were limited to providing support:

- (a) in connection with trade and commerce with other countries, or among the States; or
- (b) by way of grants of financial assistance to a State.
