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1 Name

This instrument is the *Aged Care (Subsidy, Fees and Payments) Amendment (Adjusted Subsidy Reduction Multi-purpose Services) Determination 2020*.

Schedule 1—Amendments

Aged Care (Subsidy, Fees and Payments) Determination 2014

1 Section 87 (definition of *adjusted subsidy reduction multi-purpose service*)

Repeal the definition.

2 Section 92

Repeal the section, substitute:

92 Applicable amount for high care place

The amount for a day for a high care place allocated in respect of a multi-purpose service is the amount worked out in accordance with the following formula:

$$B + C + V$$

where:

B is \$133.44.

C is the concessional resident equivalent amount specified in section 101 that relates to the region in which the service is located.

V is the viability supplement equivalent amount for the service for the day.

3 Division 5 of Part 1 of Chapter 4

Repeal the Division.
