1 Name

This instrument is the Criminal Code (Terrorist Organisation—Islamic State East Asia) Regulations 2020.

2 Commencement

5 Terrorist organisation—Islamic State East Asia

- (1) For the purposes of paragraph (b) of the definition of *terrorist organisation* in subsection 102.1(1) of the *Criminal Code*, the organisation known as Islamic State East Asia is specified.
- (2) Islamic State East Asia is also known by the following names:
 - (a) Ansharul Khilafah Philippines;
 - (b) Bangsamoro Islamic Freedom Fighters-Abubakar;
 - (c) Bangsamoro Islamic Freedom Fighters-Bungos;
 - (d) Dawlah Islamiyah-Lanao;
 - (e) Dawlah Islamiyah-Maguindanao;
 - (f) Dawlah Islamiyah-Torayfie Group;
 - (g) Dawlatul Islamiyah Waliyatul Masrik;
 - (h) Islamic State Lanao;

- (i) Islamic State-Philippines;
- (j) Islamic State Ranao;
- (k) Jama'atu al-Muhajirin wal Ansar fil Filibin;
- (l) Marawi Front;
- (m) Maute Group;
- (n) Syuful Khalifah Fi Luzon;
- (o) Wilayah East Asia.
