3 Authority

This instrument is made under section 33 of the *Industry Research and Development Act 1986*.

4 Definitions

In this instrument:

Act means the Industry Research and Development Act 1986.

Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade means the Agreement of that name set out in Annex 1A of the Marrakesh Agreement establishing the World Trade Organization, done at Marrakesh on 15 April 1994, as in force for Australia from time to time.

5 Prescribed program

(1) For the purposes of subsection 33(1) of the Act, the Support for Industry Service Organisations Program (the *program*) is prescribed.

- (2) For the purposes of assisting Australia, and Australian businesses, to influence, apply and conform to international standards, the program provides funding to the following:
 - (a) Standards Australia;
 - (b) National Association of Testing Authorities Australia;
 - (c) the Joint Accreditation System of Australia and New Zealand.

6 Specified legislative power

For the purposes of subsection 33(3) of the Act, the legislative power of the Parliament with respect to external affairs (within the meaning of paragraph 51(xxix) of the Constitution) is specified as it relates to:

- (a) measures to give effect to Australia's obligations under the Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade, particularly Articles 2 and 4; and
- (b) matters affecting Australia's relations with foreign countries.

2
