3 Authority

4 Definitions

5 Prescribed program

- (1) For the purposes of subsection 33(1) of the Act, the Beetaloo Cooperative Drilling Program (the *program*) is prescribed.
- (2) The program provides funding for exploration activities to be undertaken in the Beetaloo sub-basin to support the development of the Northern Territory gas industry.
- (3) The purpose of the program is to encourage and facilitate gas exploration in the Beetaloo sub-basin.

6 Specified legislative power

For the purposes of subsection 33(3) of the Act, the power of the Parliament to make laws with respect to the government of a Territory (within the meaning of section 122 of the Constitution) is specified.
