1 Name

This is the *Broadcasting Services (Parental Lock) Amendment Technical Standard 2021 (No.2).*

2 Commencement

Broadcasting Services (Parental Lock) Technical Standard 2020 (F2020L01182)

1 Subsection 5(1)

Insert:

designated datacasting service has the meaning given by clause 2A of Schedule 6 to the Act.

2 Subsection 5(1), definition of domestic digital television receiver

Omit the definition, substitute:

domestic digital television receiver means domestic reception equipment that:

- (a) is not a hand-held device; and
- (b) is capable of receiving one or more of the following:
 - (i) television programs broadcast or transmitted in SDTV digital mode;
 - (ii) television programs broadcast or transmitted in HDTV digital mode;
 - (iii) a designated datacasting service provided under a datacasting licence, transmitted in SDTV digital mode;
 - (iv) a designated datacasting service provided under a datacasting licence, transmitted in HDTV digital mode.

3 Subsection 5(1) (note to the subsection)

Before paragraph (c), insert:

(ba) datacasting licence;

4 Subsection 5(3)

Repeal the subsection.
