Part 1—Preliminary

1 Name of legislative instrument

This is the ASIC Corporations, Credit and Superannuation (Amendment) Instrument 2021/753.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is registered on the Federal Register of Legislation.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under:

- (a) subsection 11(4) of the Australian Securities and Investments Commission Act 2001 for the purposes of subparagraphs 912A(2)(a)(i) and 1017G(2)(a)(i) of the Corporations Act 2001; and
- (b) subsection 12A(6) of the Australian Securities and Investments Commission Act 2001 for the purposes of:
 - (i) paragraph 47(1)(b) of the *Retirement Savings Accounts Act 1997*; and
 - (ii) paragraph 101(1)(b) of the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993; and
 - (iii) subparagraph 47(1)(h)(i) of the *National Consumer Credit Protection Act 2009*; and
 - (iv) subparagraph 47(1)(e)(i) of the *National Consumer Credit Protection Act 2009* as notionally inserted by regulation 25E and Schedule 2 to the *National Consumer Credit Protection Regulations 2010*; and
- (c) subsection 47(2A) of the *Retirement Savings Accounts Act 1997* and subsection 101(1B) of the *Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993*.

4 Schedules
