## 1 Name

This instrument is the *Australian Capital Territory National Land (Road Transport) (Parking Authority Guidelines) Rules 2021*.

## 2 Commencement

## 3 Authority

This instrument is made under the *National Land (Road Transport) Ordinance 2014*.

## 4 Schedules

## 5 Definitions

In this instrument:

**Ordinance** means the *National Land (Road Transport) Ordinance 2014*.

## 6 ACT paid parking legislation

For the purposes of paragraph (b) of the definition of **ACT paid parking legislation** in section 5 of the Ordinance, sections 33 and 34 of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2017* (ACT) are declared to be part of the ACT paid parking legislation.

## **7 Parking authorities**

For the purposes of subparagraph 11(2)(b)(i) of the Ordinance, section 33 of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2017 (ACT)* applies to National Land as if subsection (3) of that section were replaced with the following subsection:

- (3) The declaration is a legislative instrument (within the meaning of the *Legislation Act 2003 (Commonwealth)*).

## **8 Parking authority guidelines**

For the purposes of subparagraph 11(2)(b)(i) of the Ordinance, section 34 of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2017 (ACT)* applies to National Land as if subsection (2) of that section were replaced with the following subsection:

- (2) The parking authority guidelines are a legislative instrument (within the meaning of the *Legislation Act 2003 (Commonwealth)*).
