1 Name

This instrument is the National Health (Supplies of out-patient medication) Amendment Determination 2021.

This instrument may also be cited as PB 136 of 2021.

2 Commencement

This Determination commences on 1 January 2022.

Schedule 1—Amendments

National Health (Supplies of out-patient medication) Determination 2019 (No. 2)

1 Section 8(1)

Repeal the paragraph, substitute:

(1) The maximum value of the supply of out-patient medication to a person who is a general patient and who is not the holder of a concession card is \$34.00.
