3 Authority

This instrument is made under paragraph 917C(3)(b) of the *Social Security Act* 1991.

4 Definitions

In this instrument:

Act means the Social Security Act 1991.

5 Medical Conditions

- (1) Each of the following medical conditions is a specified medical condition for the purposes of paragraph 917C(1)(b) of the Act:
 - (a) Spinal cord injury at or above the T7 level;
 - (b) Stroke;
 - (c) Brain injury;
 - (d) Neurodegenerative disorder;
 - (e) Muscular dystrophies;
 - (f) Full thickness burns covering more than 20 per cent of the body surface area;
 - (g) Rare disorders of sweating including congenital absence or mal-development of sweat glands;
 - (h) Chronic erythrodermas.
