- (b) Family Law Regulations 1984;
- (c) Family Law (Superannuation) Regulations 2001.
- Note: The *Legislation (Family Law Instruments) Sunset-altering Declaration 2018* declared the sunsetting day of 1 April 2023 for the above instruments.

5 Repeal of this instrument

This instrument is repealed at the start of 2 April 2024.
