- (1) The following instruments, for which the sunseting day is 1 April 2022, are repealed by section 51 of the *Legislation Act 2003* on 1 April 2024:
- Autonomous Sanctions Regulations 2011*;
 - Autonomous Sanctions (Sanction Law) Declaration 2012*.
- (2) The *Autonomous Sanctions (Export Sanctioned Goods - Syria) Designation 2012*, for which the sunseting day is 1 October 2022, is repealed by section 51 of the *Legislation Act 2003* on 1 April 2024.

5 Repeal of this instrument

This instrument is repealed at the start of 2 April 2024.
