4 Deferral of sunsetting

- (1) The following instruments, for which the sunsetting day is 1 April 2022, are repealed by section 51 of the *Legislation Act 2003* on 1 April 2024:
 - (a) Autonomous Sanctions Regulations 2011;
 - (b) Autonomous Sanctions (Sanction Law) Declaration 2012.
- (2) The Autonomous Sanctions (Export Sanctioned Goods Syria) Designation 2012, for which the sunsetting day is 1 October 2022, is repealed by section 51 of the Legislation Act 2003 on 1 April 2024.

5 Repeal of this instrument

This instrument is repealed at the start of 2 April 2024.
