

Woomera Prohibited Area Amendment Rule (No.1) 2021

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1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Woomera Prohibited Area Amendment Rule (No.1) 2021.

2 Commencement

Schedule 1—Amendments

Woomera Prohibited Area Rule 2014

1. Subsection 63(1)

Repeal the subsection, substitute:

- (1) The Minister, by writing, may delegate his or her powers or functions under section 62 to review decisions (other than a decision under section 38 or 41) to:
 - (a) the Secretary; or
 - (b) an APS employee who holds or performs the duties of an SES Band 2 position, or an equivalent or higher position, in the Department.

2 Subsection 63(2)

Repeal the subsection, substitute:

- (2) The Minister, by writing, may delegate his or her powers or functions under this rule (other than the Minister's powers or functions under section 62 to review decisions) to:
 - (a) the Secretary; or
 - (b) an APS employee who holds or performs the duties of an Executive Level 1 position, or an equivalent or higher position, in the Department; or
 - (c) an officer of the Navy who holds the rank of Commander or a higher rank; or
 - (d) an officer of the Army who holds the rank of Lieutenant-Colonel or a higher rank; or
 - (e) an officer of the Air Force who holds the rank of Wing Commander or a higher rank.
