544 Australian Future Leaders Program To provide funding for the Australian Future Leaders Foundation Limited to establish and deliver a national leadership development program, as a measure that is peculiarly adapted to the government of a nation and cannot otherwise be carried on for the benefit of the nation.

This objective also has the effect it would have if it were limited to measures with respect to postal, telegraphic, telephonic, and other like services (within the meaning of paragraph 51(v) of the Constitution).
