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1 Name

This instrument is the *Health Insurance (Bonded Medical Program) Amendment Rule (No. 1) 2022*.

Schedule 1—Amendments

Health Insurance (Bonded Medical Program) Rule 2020

1 Section 4 (definition of *per-day basis*)

Repeal the definition, substitute:

per-day basis: a bonded participant completes 1 week of their return of service obligation on a *per-day basis*, if they are employed in eligible work on two or more days with a total of at least 20 hours.
