Decision and reasons for decision of Australian Information Commissioner, Ms Angelene Falk

Decision on variation under s 26T of the Privacy Act 1988

- 1. In accordance with s 26T(1) of the *Privacy Act 1988* (Privacy Act), I approve the *Privacy (Credit Reporting) Code 2014 (Version 2.2)* (CR Code v2.2), which varies the registered *Privacy (Credit Reporting) Code 2014 (Version 2)* (CR Code v2.1).
- 2. I direct that, in accordance with s 26T(5) of the Privacy Act, the existing CR Code v2.1 be removed and the CR Code v2.2 be included on the Codes Register and registered on the Federal Register of Legislation.
- 3. In making this decision to vary the registered CR Code v2.1, I have taken into account the requirements for variation of the registered CR Code set out in s 26T of the Privacy Act. I have also considered the matters specified in the *Guidelines for developing codes* issued under s 26V.¹
- 4. The CR Code v2.2 commences on 22 April 2022.
