## 1 Name

This is the Amendment Statement of Principles concerning *immune thrombocytopaenia (Balance of Probabilities)* (No. 58 of 2022).

The Statement of Principles concerning *immune thrombocytopaenia (Balance of Probabilities)* (No. 64 of 2017) (Federal Register of Legislation No. F2017L01449) is amended in the following manner:

<i>Schedule 1 – Dictionary</i>	<i>Insert the following note to the definition of "specified list of viral infections":</i> Note: SARS-CoV-2 is the virus which causes coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).
