## 1 Name

## Schedule 1—Amendments

### *Defence Force Discipline (Consequences of Punishment) Rules 2018*

#### **1 Section 3**

Omit “subsections 68(2), 68A(2) and 169FB(1)”, substitute “subsections 9J(1), 68(2) and 68A(2)”.

#### **2 Section 5 (note)**

Repeal the note, substitute:

- Note: A number of expressions used in this instrument are defined in the Act, including the following:
- (a) defence member;
  - (b) detainee;
  - (c) detention centre;
  - (d) prescribed defence member;
  - (e) punishment;
  - (f) service tribunal.

#### **3 Section 5 (definition of *member*)**

Repeal the definition, substitute:

*member* means a defence member.

#### **4 Section 5 (definition of *prescribed defence member*)**

Repeal the definition.

#### **5 Part 2 (heading)**

Omit “sections 68 and 169FB”, substitute “sections 9J and 68”.

#### **6 Sections 8, 9 and 10**

Omit “subsections 68(2) and 169FB(1)”, substitute “subsections 9J(1) and 68(2)”.
