## 1 Name

This instrument is the *Southern Squid Jig Fishery (Total Allowable Effort) Determination 2022*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 January 2023.

## 3 Cessation

This instrument ceases on 1 January 2024.

## 4 Authority

This instrument is made under section 11 of the Management Plan for the purpose of paragraph 17(6)(aa) of the Act.

## 5 Definitions

Note: A number of expressions used in this instrument are defined in the definitions section of the Management Plan, including the following:

- (a) *fishing year*;
- (b) *standard squid jigging machine*; and
- (c) *total allowable effort or TAE*;

In this instrument:

*Management Plan* means *Southern Squid Jig Fishery Management Plan 2005*.

*Act* means *the Fisheries Management Act 1991*.

## 6 Determination of total allowable effort

The total allowable effort for the Southern Squid Jig Fishery for the 2023 fishing year, commencing on 1 January 2023 and ending on 31 December 2023 (inclusive), is 550 standard squid jigging machines.
