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1 Name

8 Appointment of the Registrar under the Foreign Acquisitions and Takeovers Act

Under section 130R of the *Foreign Acquisitions and Takeovers Act 1975*, the person holding or performing the duties of the Commissioner of Taxation (from time to time) is appointed as Registrar (within the meaning of that Act) in relation to all the functions and powers of the Registrar.

Omit "on the day the request for approval to take recreation leave is made", substitute "as at the day before the requested recreation leave is proposed to commence".

(3) In determining an applicant's accrued entitlement on a particular day for the purposes of subsection (2), deduct from that entitlement any recreation leave that has been approved to be taken after that particular day.

Insert:

7 Delegation to grant long service leave to full-time members

Under subsection 9(1) of the *Long Service Leave (Commonwealth Employees) Act 1976*, the Chair of the Commission is delegated the Minister's powers under section 16 of the Act, as an approving authority, to grant a full-time member of the Commission long service leave.
