#### 1 Name

This instrument is the *Telecommunications (Carrier Licence Conditions)*Amendment (Networks supplying Superfast Carriage Services to Residential Customers) Instrument 2022.

#### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is registered.

## 3 Authority

This instrument is made under subsection 63(5) of the *Telecommunications Act* 1997.

# **Schedule 1—Amendments**

Carrier Licence Conditions (Networks supplying Superfast Carriage Services to Residential Customers) Declaration 2014

# 1 Paragraph 5(1)(c) (Application)

Omit the paragraph, substitute:

(c) no functional separation undertaking relating to local access lines forming part of the designated telecommunications network given by the specified carrier or any of its associates is in force.

### 2 Subsection 5(2) (Application)

Omit the subsection, substitute:

- A reference in paragraph (1)(c) to a functional separation undertaking given by a specified carrier or an associate of the specified carrier is a reference to a functional separation undertaking given by the specified carrier or the associate (as the case may be) either:
  - (a) alone; or
  - (b) jointly with one or more other persons.
