1 Name

This is the *Telecommunications Legislation Amendment (Significant Event) Instrument (No. 1) 2023.*

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 2 March 2023.

1 Subsection 4(1) (definition of significant event)

Repeal the definition, substitute:

significant event means:

- (a) an event declared by the ACMA under subsection 54A(2) of the *Radiocommunications Equipment (General) Rules 2021*; or
- (b) if an event (the *relevant event*) was a significant event (within the meaning of this Instrument as in force immediately before the commencement of the *Telecommunications Legislation Amendment (Significant Event) Instrument (No. 1)* 2023) and the whole or a part of the relevant event occurs after that commencement the relevant event.

2 Section 4 (definition of Chair)

Repeal the definition.

3 Section 4 (definition of significant event)

Repeal the definition, substitute:

significant event means:

- (a) an event declared by the ACMA under subsection 54A(2) of the *Radiocommunications Equipment (General) Rules 2021*; or
- (b) if an event (the *relevant event*) was a significant event (within the meaning of this Declaration as in force immediately before the commencement of the *Telecommunications Legislation Amendment (Significant Event) Instrument (No. 1)* 2023) and the whole or a part of the relevant event occurs after that commencement the relevant event.
