1 Name

This instrument is the Legislation (Airport Curfew Instruments) Sunset-altering Declaration 2023.

2 Commencement

- (c) Air Navigation (Gold Coast Airport Curfew) Regulations 2018;
- (d) Sydney Airport Curfew (Curfew Aircraft) Instrument 2015;
- (e) Sydney Airport Curfew (Dispensation) Guideline 2016.

5 Repeal of this instrument

This instrument is repealed at the start of 2 April 2029.
