

# **Radiocommunications (Amateur Licences – Renewal Statement) Determination 2023**

## 1 Name

This is the *Radiocommunications (Amateur Licences – Renewal Statement)* Determination 2023.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 19 February 2024.

### **3** Authority

This instrument is made under subsection 103A(5) of the Act.

### **4** Interpretation

- (1) In this instrument, unless the contrary intention appears, an amateur licence is a *relevant amateur licence* if it authorises the operation of a radiocommunications transmitter that is not:
  - (a) an amateur beacon station; or
  - (b) an amateur repeater station.
- (2) In this instrument, unless the contrary intention appears, each of the terms listed in subsection (3) has the meaning given by:
  - (a) the Radiocommunications (Interpretation) Determination 2015; or
  - (b) if another instrument replaces that determination and defines the term the other instrument.
  - Note: The *Radiocommunications (Interpretation) Determination 2015* is registered on the Federal Register of Legislation and is available free of charge at <u>www.legislation.gov.au</u>.
- (3) For the purposes of subsection (2), the terms are:
  - (a) Act;
  - (b) amateur beacon station;
  - (c) *amateur licence*;
  - (d) amateur repeater station.

Note: An amateur licence is a type of transmitter licence determined under section 98 of the Act.

#### **5** References to other instruments

In this instrument, unless the contrary intention appears:

- (a) a reference to any other legislative instrument is a reference to that other legislative instrument as in force from time to time; and
- (b) a reference to any other kind of instrument or writing is a reference to that other instrument or writing as in force, or existing, from time to time.
- Note 1: For references to Commonwealth Acts, see section 10 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*; and see also subsection 13(1) of the *Legislation Act 2003* for the application of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* to legislative instruments.
- Note 2: All Commonwealth Acts and legislative instruments are registered on the Federal Register of Legislation.

## 6 Renewal statement

Each relevant amateur licence is taken to include a statement to the effect that the licence cannot be renewed.
