1 Name

Code means the *Port Terminal Access (Bulk Wheat) Code of Conduct* as set out in Schedule 1 to the *Competition and Consumer (Industry Code—Port Terminal Access (Bulk Wheat)) Regulation 2014.*

5 Determination

Under subclause 5(2) of the Code, the ACCC determines that Consolidated Ag Pty Ltd (ACN 164 749 151) as trustee of The Cadalelup Trust trading as Commodity Ag, is an exempt service provider of port terminal services provided by means of its port terminal facility at Albany, Western Australia.
