4 Deferral of sunsetting

The following instruments, for which the sunsetting day is 1 April 2024, are repealed by section 51 of the *Legislation Act 2003* on 1 April 2026:

- (a) Migration Agents (IMMI 17/047: CPD Activities, Approval of CPD Providers and CPD Provider Standards) Instrument 2017;
- (b) Migration Agents Registration Application Charge Regulations 1998;
- (c) Migration Agents Regulations 1998;
- (d) Migration (IMMI 18/003: Specified courses and exams for registration as a migration agent) Instrument 2018.

Note: The Legislation (Migration Agents Instruments) Sunset-altering Declaration 2019 declared the sunsetting day of 1 April 2024 for the above instruments.

5 Repeal of this instrument

This instrument is repealed at the start of 2 April 2026.
