1 Name

5 Definitions

In this instrument:

Act means the *Commonwealth Places (Application of Laws) Act 1970*.

6 Designated State airports

For the purposes of the definition of *designated State airport* in section 3 of the Act, the following airports are prescribed:

- Adelaide Airport;
- Brisbane Airport;
- Coolangatta Airport (being the Gold Coast Airport);
- Hobart Airport;
- Melbourne Airport (being the Tullamarine Airport);

- (f) Perth Airport;
- (g) Sydney (Kingsford Smith) Airport.
