1 Name

This instrument is the *Public Health (Tobacco and Other Products)* (Consequential Amendments) Regulations 2024.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under the following:

- (a) the Tobacco Advertising Prohibition Act 1992;
- (b) the Tobacco Plain Packaging Act 2011;
- (c) the Customs Act 1901.

4 Schedules

Each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.

Schedule 1—Repeals

Tobacco Advertising Prohibition Regulation 1993

1 The whole of the instrument Repeal the instrument.

Tobacco Plain Packaging Regulations 2011

2 The whole of the instrument

Schedule 2—Consequential amendments

Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956

1 Subregulation 4DA(2) (note 2)

Repeal the note, substitute:

Note 2: Subregulation 4(2) prohibits the importation of chewing tobacco and snuffs intended for oral use unless certain conditions and restrictions are complied with (see Schedule 3).

2 Schedule 3 (at the end of the table)

Add:

12 Goods that are chewing tobacco or snuffs intended for oral use The goods must not be imported unless the quantity imported is no greater than 1.5 kilograms

3 Schedule 12 (table item 5)

Repeal the item.
