Amendment of List of Exempt Native Specimens – Western Australian Octopus Fisheries, May 2024

I, BELINDA JAGO, Branch Head, Ocean and Wildlife Branch, as Delegate of the Minister for the Environment and Water, pursuant to subsection 303DC(1)(a) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act), hereby amend the list of exempt native specimens established under section 303DB of the EPBC Act by **deleting** from the list specimens and associated notations as set out in the **Schedule 1**, and **including** in the list specimens and associated notations as set out in the **Schedule 2**.

This instrument is a legislative instrument for the purposes of the *Legislation Act 2003*.
