1 Name

This instrument is the *Criminal Code (Terrorist Organisation—Ansar Allah) Regulations 2024*.

2 Commencement

3 Authority

This instrument is made under the *Criminal Code Act 1995*.

4 Terrorist organisation—Ansar Allah

- (1) For the purposes of paragraph (b) of the definition of **terrorist organisation** in subsection 102.1(1) of the *Criminal Code*, the organisation known as Ansar Allah is specified.
- (2) Ansar Allah is also known by the following names:
- (a) al’anasir al-Huthyia;
 - (b) al-Harala al-Huthiya;
 - (c) al-Huythiyin;
 - (d) Ansar al-Huthi;
 - (e) Ansarallah;
 - (f) Ansarullah;
 - (g) al-Shabab al-Mu’min;
 - (h) Believing Youth Elements;
 - (i) Houthis;
 - (j) the Houthi movement;
 - (k) Houthist elements;
 - (l) Houthi supporters;
 - (m) Huthis;
 - (n) the Huthi movement;

- (p) Huthi supporters;
- (q) Partisans of God;
- (r) Supporters of God.
