## **Notice of Intention to Propose Customs Tariff Alteration (No. 2) 2024**

In accordance with section 273EA of the *Customs Act 1901*, read with section 56 of the *Legislation Act 2003*, I, Suzanne Ford, delegate of the Minister for Home Affairs, give notice that it is intended, within 7 sitting days of the House of Representatives after the date of registration of this Notice, to propose in the Parliament a Customs Tariff alteration in accordance with the particulars specified in the Schedules to this Notice.

The alteration in Schedule 1 operated starting on 4 July 2024.

## **Schedule 1—Alteration to the *Customs Tariff Act 1995* operating start on 4 July 2024**

### **1 Paragraph 18B(1)(b)**

Repeal the paragraph, substitute:

- (b) that are imported into Australia during the period beginning on 4 July 2022 and ending at the end of 3 July 2026;
