## **1 Name**

This instrument is the *Higher Education Support (Other Grants) Amendment (National Priorities Pool Program) Guidelines 2024*.

## **2 Commencement**

This instrument commences the day after this instrument is registered.

## **3 Authority**

This instrument is made under section 238-10 of the *Higher Education Support Act 2003*.

## **4 Schedules**

Each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.

## Schedule 1—Amendments

### *Higher Education Support (Other Grants) Guidelines 2022*

#### **1 Subsection 14(2)**

After the word “providers”, insert “and specified bodies corporate”.

#### **2 Paragraph 14(2)(b)**

Omit “and”.

#### **3 Paragraph 14(2)(c)**

Omit “.”, substitute “; and”.

#### **4 After paragraph 14(2)(c)**

Insert:

- (d) address barriers to education including through embedding inclusive education, universal design for teaching and learning and improved cultural safety.

#### **5 Section 15**

Repeal the section, substitute:

##### **15 Specified bodies corporate**

The Australian Human Rights Commission is specified as eligible to receive a grant under the National Priorities Pool Program.

Note: Under section 41-10 of the Act, Table A providers are eligible for grants made for the purpose of promoting equality of opportunity in higher education.
