1 Name

Radiocommunications (Spectrum Licence Tax) Determination 2021 (F2021L01256)

1 Clause 1 of Schedule 2 (definition of total annual EME Component)

Omit the definition (including the note), substitute:

total annual EME Component means, for the 2024-2025 financial year, \$2,090,532.
