#### 1 Name

This instrument is the *Telecommunications (Communications Security Coordinator) Specification 2024.* 

#### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the later of:

- (a) the day after this instrument is registered; and
- (b) the day Schedule 4 of the *Crimes and Other Legislation Amendment* (*Omnibus No. 1*) *Act 2024* commences.

## **3** Authority

This instrument is made under subsection 7A(2) of the Act.

#### 4 Definitions

- Note:
- A number of expressions used in this instrument are defined in section 7 of the Act, including the following:
  - (a) Communications Security Coordinator;
  - (b) Home Affairs Department; and
  - (c) Home Affairs Minister.

In this instrument:

Act means the Telecommunications Act 1997.

APS employee has the meaning given by the Public Service Act 1999.

*Cyber and Infrastructure Security Group* means the Group of the same name in the Home Affairs Department.

SES employee has the meaning given by the Public Service Act 1999.

## **5** Specification

- (1) For the definition of Communications Security Coordinator in paragraph 7A(1)(b) of the Act, APS employees in the Home Affairs Department holding, occupying or performing the duties of a SES employee in the Cyber and Infrastructure Security Group are specified.
- (2) For subsection 7A(4) of the Act, all of the functions and powers of a Communications Security Coordinator under a provision of the Act are specified to be functions and powers that a person mentioned in subsection (1) may perform or exercise.
