

#### 1 Name

This instrument is the List of Exempt Native Specimens Amendment (Western Australian Gascoyne Demersal Scalefish Managed Fishery) Instrument January 2025.

#### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is registered.

#### 3 Authority

This instrument is made under subsection 303DC(1)(a) of the EPBC Act.

#### 4 Definitions

In this instrument:

**EPBC** Act means the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999.
