#### 1 Name

This instrument is the *Telecommunications Code of Practice (Installation Certificate Waivers) Amendment Instrument 2025.* 

#### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is registered.

## **Schedule 1—Amendments**

## Telecommunications Code of Practice 2021

### 1 Subsection 1A.7(3)

Repeal the subsection, substitute:

- (3) Paragraph 1(a) does not apply if:
  - (a) the owner is party to an agreement with the carrier that includes a separate engineering assurance process for the installation of the facility; and
  - (b) the owner has agreed with the carrier to waive the requirements of paragraph (1)(a).
- (4) Paragraph 1(b) does not apply if:
  - (a) the occupier is party to an agreement with the carrier that includes a separate engineering assurance process for the installation of the facility; and
  - (b) the occupier has agreed with the carrier to waive the requirements of paragraph (1)(b).
- (5) Subsection (1) does not apply if:
  - (a) the owner is a party to an agreement with the occupier that allows one party, or both parties, to waive the requirements of subsection (1); and
  - (b) either the owner or the occupier is a party to an agreement with the carrier that includes a separate engineering assurance process for the installation of the facility; and
  - (c) the waiving party has agreed with the carrier to waive the requirements of subsection (1).
