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1 Name

This instrument is the *Financial Framework (Supplementary Powers)* Amendment (Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water Measures No. 1) Regulations 2025.

2 Commencement

 To provide ongoing funding and support for fishers and other users of areas of sea that, under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*, are declared as Commonwealth reserves, where:

 (a) the areas of sea are outside Australia and are in Commonwealth marine areas; and
 - (b) the funding and support is for the fishers and other users to:
 - (i) adjust to changes in access and regulatory requirements resulting from new or revised zoning arrangements in those Commonwealth reserves; or
 - (ii) engage in projects that further the objects of those Commonwealth reserves.

		 (b) to give effect to Australia's obligations under one or more of the following: (i) the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, particularly Article 4; (ii) the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, particularly Article 10; (iii) the Paris Agreement, particularly Articles 4 and 10.
