1 Paragraph 4.7(a)

Omit “by reason of either”, substitute “by reason of any”.

2 Subparagraph 4.7(a)(ii)

Omit “State); and”, substitute “State);”.

3 At the end of paragraph 4.7(a)

Add:

- (iii) the person was a member of the House of Representatives for an electoral division that ceased to exist because of an electoral redistribution; and

4 Subparagraph 4.7(b)(ii)

Omit “employment.”, substitute “employment; and”.

5 After paragraph 4.7(b)

Insert:

- (c) if the person is a former member because of the circumstance mentioned in subparagraph (a)(iii) of this section, the person did not contest the election immediately following the relevant redistribution.
