WE Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the House of Preamble. Representatives in Parliament assembled towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the 5 sum hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia in Parliament assembled as follows:—
