2	(1) All duties of excise demanded or collected before 14 May 2009
3	because of the excise tariff proposal proposed in the House of
4	Representatives on 13 May 2008 are taken to have been lawfully
5	imposed and lawfully demanded or collected.
6	(2) Subsection (1) applies to duties of excise whether they were
7	demanded or collected:
8	(a) at the rate proposed in the excise tariff proposal proposed in
9	the House of Representatives on 13 May 2008; or
10	(b) at a higher rate resulting from indexation of the rate proposed
11	on 13 May 2008 or from indexation of the result of
12	indexation of that rate.
