1 **A Bill for an Act to amend legislation relating to**
2 **exports, and for related purposes**

3 The Parliament of Australia enacts:

4 **1 Short title**

5 This Act may be cited as the *Export Inspection (Establishment*
6 *Registration Charges) Amendment Act 2014*.

7 **2 Commencement**

8 (1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table
9 commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with
10 column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect
11 according to its terms.

9 repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule
10 concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this Act has effect
11 according to its terms.

Schedule 1—Amendments

Export Inspection (Establishment Registration Charges) Act 1985

1 Section 4

Repeal the section, substitute:

4 Definitions

In this Act:

charge means charge imposed by this Act.

exportable goods means goods that are:

- (a) prescribed goods (within the meaning of the *Export Control Act 1982*); and
- (b) prescribed in regulations made for the purposes of this definition.

2 Subsection 6(1)

Repeal the subsection, substitute:

- (1) Charges are imposed, in accordance with the regulations, in relation to the registration of an establishment for operations associated with the preparation of exportable goods.

3 Application of amendments

The amendments made by this Schedule apply in relation to registrations (including renewals of registrations) made on or after the first day of the first financial year starting on or after the commencement of this Schedule.

4 Transitional—initial regulations

- (1) This item applies to the *Export Inspection (Establishment Registration Charges) Regulations 1985* (as in force immediately before the commencement of this item).

- 1 (2) The regulations (to the extent that they specify or refer to commodities)
2 have effect, after the commencement of this item, as if:
3 (a) any of those commodities that is not a prescribed good
4 (within the meaning of the *Export Control Act 1982*) were
5 disregarded; and
6 (b) the remaining commodities were goods prescribed for the
7 purposes of the definition of **exportable goods** in section 4 of
8 the *Export Inspection (Establishment Registration Charges)*
9 *Act 1985* as amended by this Act.
- 10 (3) The regulations (to the extent that they specify or refer to a charge for
11 the purposes of subsection 6(1) of the *Export Inspection (Establishment*
12 *Registration Charges) Act 1985*) have effect, after the commencement
13 of this item, as if the charge were specified or referred to for the
14 purposes of that subsection as amended by this Act.
